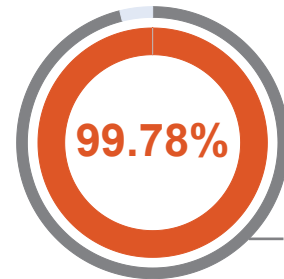

developing children.

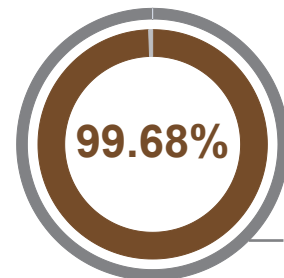

justified within 45 days.

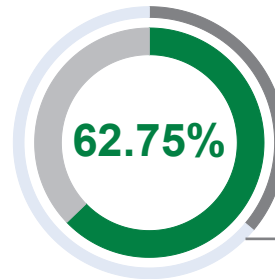

REGULAR CHILDHOOD PROGRAM

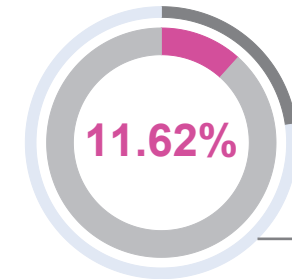
Children receiving majority of ECSE services in a regular

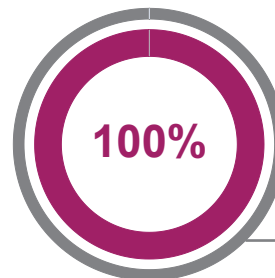

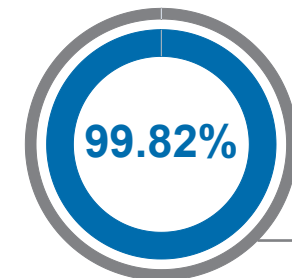

Early Intervention (EI)

A special education program for children from birth to age three,
who have developmental delays or a medical condition likely to
result in a developmental delay.

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)

A special education program for children age three to school age
with developmental delays and/or other disabilities that qualify
them for special education.

Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)

A plan for special services and special education for infants,
toddlers, and children ages three to five with developmental
delays.

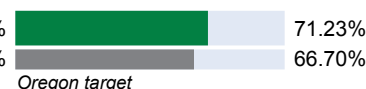
PREPARING INFANTS, TODDLERS FOR PRESCHOOL

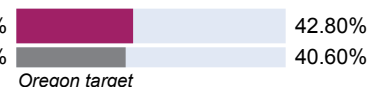
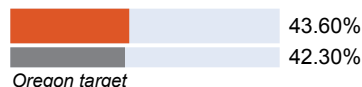

Preschool children who entered the preschool program below age expectations and substantially increased their rate of growth by age 6 or when they exited the program.

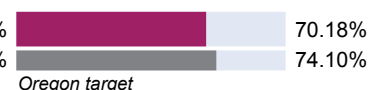

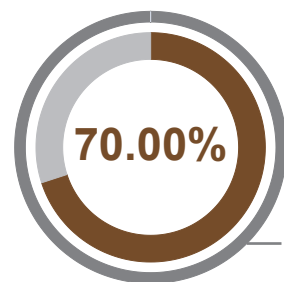

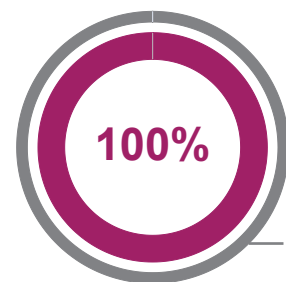
EI IFSP WITH TRANSITION STEPS
